The Word

In the future time, the perfection of spiritual work will come through friendship, when human friendship is perfected in the sacredness of the word and comes back on this physical plane in the expression of everyday life. This will be the religion of the future, and the expression of this religion will transform the consciousness of humankind. It will not be Hinduism, nor Buddhism; it will be the religion of humanity expressed through the sacredness of the word in the perfection of friendship. Then we will really know that the word is God.

I Understand I Agree

To say, "I understand and I agree" is to see through the guru's eyes, the transformative power of God, and act on what one sees. "Gu" means darkness and "ru" means light, so
